IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- Respondent is placed under provisional liquidation in the hands of the 1. Master of the High Court.
- 2. That a rule *nisi* do issue calling upon all persons interested to show cause, if any to this Court on THURSDAY 31 MARCH 2011 at 10h00 why:
 - Respondent should not be placed under final liquidation; 2.1.

- 2.2. The costs of this Application should not be costs in the liquidation of Respondent.
- 3. That service of this Order is to be effected:
 - 3.1. At the registered office of the Respondent;
 - 3.2. By one publication in each of the CAPE TIMES and DIE BURGER newspapers;
 - 3.3. On the offices of the South African Revenue Service:
 - 3.4. Upon Respondent's employees by affixing a copy to any notice board to which the employees have access inside Respondent's premises or if there is no access to the premises by the employees, by affixing a copy to the front gate where applicable, failing which to the front door of the premises from which Respondent conducted any business at the time of the Application;
 - 3.5. The South African Clothing Workers Union;
 - 3.6. The National Union of Leather Workers.

4. That creditors with claims in excess of R5 000,00 are to be advised by registered post.
