Having heard counsel for the Applicant and having read the documents filed of record;

**It is ordered that:**

1. The Respondent is placed under provisional winding up in the hands of the Master of the above Honourable Court;
2. A *rule nisi* is issued calling upon all persons concerned to appear and show cause, if any, to this Honourable Court at 10h00 on 6 May 2011 as to why a final winding up order should not be granted and why the costs of this application should not be costs in the winding up of the Respondent;
3. That a copy of this order be served by the Sheriff as follows:

- 3.1 on the Respondent at its registered address at 20 Main Road, Erndor Building, Knysna, Western Cape;
  - 3.2 on the South African Revenue Services;
  - 3.3 upon the employees of the Respondent by affixing a copy of the order to any notice board to which the aforesaid employees have access inside the Respondent's premises at 20 Main Road, Erndor Building, Knysna, Western Cape or, if there is no such access by affixing a copy of the order to the front gate of the premises, failing which, the front door of the aforesaid premises.
  - 3.4 upon every registered trade union of which any of the aforesaid employees are members;
4. That service of the order further be effected by way of publication in one issue of each of the Cape Times and Die Burger news papers.
