ORDER

Having read the papers and having heard Counsel for the Applicant, the following Order is hereby made:

1. The Respondent is placed under provisional liquidation;
2. A rule *nisi* is issued, calling upon all persons interested to appear at and show cause, if any, to the above Honourable Court on **Monday, 21 February 2011** at **10:00** or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard:

2.1. Why the Respondent should not be placed under final liquidation; and

2.2. Why the costs of the application should not be costs in the liquidation;



3. Service of the Order must be effected as follows:

- 3.1. By one publication in each of the *Cape Times* and *Die Burger* newspapers;
- 3.2. By service on the South African Revenue Services at 22 Hans Strijdom Avenue, Cape Town;
- 3.3. By service on the Respondent at its registered address, being 1 Setchell Road, Roodekop, Germiston;
- 3.4. By service on the Respondent's employees at its main place of business, being 6 Hawkens Avenue, Epping, Western Cape; and
- 3.5. By service on all registered trade unions, representing the Respondent's employees, if any.
