Having heard Counsel for the Applicant and having read the papers filed of record,
the following order is made:

1. The Respondent is placed under a provisional winding-up order in the hands of the Master of the High Court;
2. A rule *nisi* is issued calling upon all persons concerned to appear and show cause, if any, to this Honourable Court at 10h00 on **THURSDAY** the **24th** day of **MARCH 2011**, why a final winding-up order should not be granted, and why the costs of this application should not be costs in the winding-up;



3. Service of this order is to be effected:

- 3.1 By the Sheriff upon the Respondent at its registered address at 21A Western Avenue, Selborne, East London;
- 3.2 By the Sheriff upon the Respondent at its principal place of business at Units 21 and 22, Creation Park, Computer Road, Marconi Beam, Cape Town;
- 3.3 By the Sheriff upon the Respondent's employees at its principal place of business at Units 21 and 22, Creation Park, Computer Road, Marconi Beam, Cape Town;
- 3.4 By the Sheriff upon any trade union which the Sheriff may establish represents any employees of the Respondent;
- 3.5 By the Sheriff upon the South African Revenue Services at 22 Hans Strijdom Street, Cape Town;
- 3.6 By publication in one edition of each of the Cape Times and Die Burger newspapers;
- 3.7 By prepaid registered mail to all known creditors of the Respondent with claims against it in excess of R5000.00.
