2.2. That the costs of this application should be costs in the liquidation.

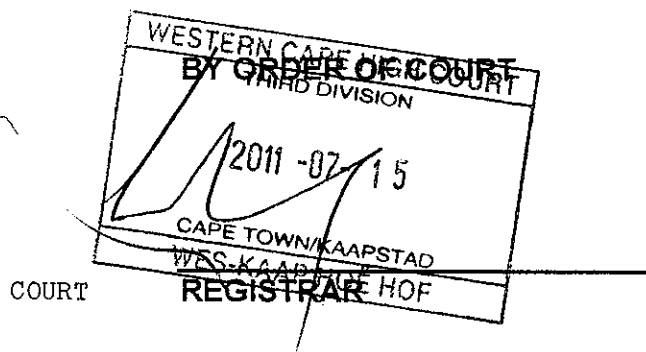
3. That service of this order be effected:
