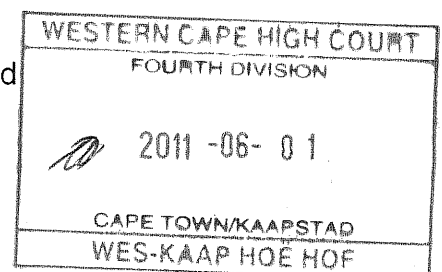

DRAFT ORDER

AFTER perusing the papers filed of record and hearing counsel for the applicants, it
is ordered:

- 1 That the Respondent be placed under provisional winding-up in the hands of the
Master of the above Honourable Court.
- 2 That a *Rule Nisi* be issued calling upon all persons concerned to appear and
show cause, if any, to this Honourable Court on 28 June 2011, as to why:-

- 2.1 a final winding-up order should not be granted; and



2.2 the costs of this application should not be costs in the winding up of the Respondent.

3 That a copy of this Order be served as follows:-

3.1 on the Respondent at its registered address at 20 Main Road, Erndor Building, Knysna, Western Cape;

3.2 by way of publication in one issue of each the Cape Times and Die Burger newspapers respectively;

3.3 on the South African Revenue Service;

3.4 upon the employees of the Respondent by affixing a copy of the Order to any notice board to which the aforesaid employees have access inside the Respondent's premises, or if it is not possible, by affixing a copy of the Order to the front gate of the premises, failing which, the front door of the aforesaid premises; and

3.5 upon Solidarity Trade Union and the National Security Workers' Union, being the trade unions to which the Respondent's employees belong;

3.6 by way of pre-paid registered mail to all known creditors with claims above R10 000.
