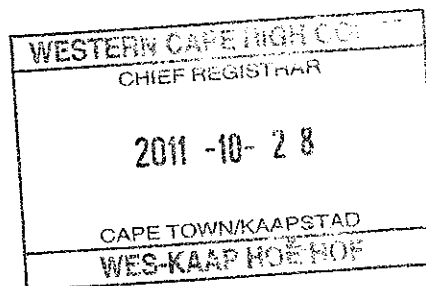

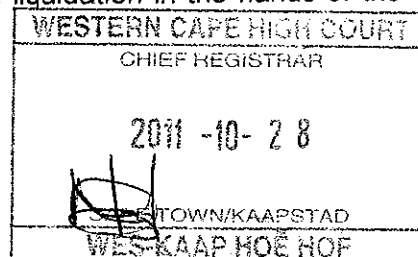

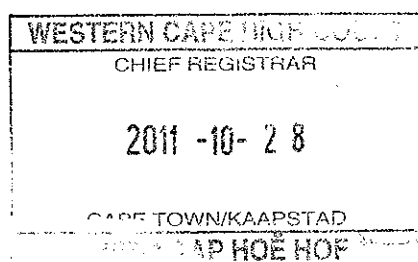
ORDER

Having read the papers and having heard counsel it is ordered:

1. Leave is granted in terms of Section 84(1A)(b)(ii) of the Banks Act, 94 of 1990, to proceed with the liquidation proceedings instituted in this matter against the Respondent.
2. That the Respondent be placed in provisional liquidation in the hands of the Master of the above Honourable Court.



3. That a rule *nisi* be issued returnable on 8 December 2011 calling upon all interested parties to show cause, if any, to the above Honourable Court on a date to be determined by the Honourable Court, as to why:
 - 3.1. a final order of liquidation should not be granted;
 - 3.2. costs of this application including the costs of the Registrar and the costs of two counsel should not be costs in the liquidation.
4. That service of the rule *nisi* shall be effected:
 - 4.1. on the Respondent at the principal place of business of the Respondent by the Sheriff;
 - 4.2. on the employees of the Respondent at the principal place of business of the Respondent by the Sheriff / the Applicant's attorney;
 - 4.3. at the South African Revenue Service by the Applicant's attorney;
 - 4.4. by one publication thereof in each of Die Burger and The Cape Times newspapers; and
 - 4.5. by means of service of the order on all known creditors with claims in excess of R5 000,00 by registered mail.
